'Recollections'

As you probably are aware, I used to hold the post of Senior C/S Flag. That was until the end of 1978. Let me start this narrative article from that point.

In September of 1978. I was sitting in my office one day C/Sing some folders and a messenger came into the office with a telex which was one of these very secret “your eyes only” telexes. So I grabbed some clothes, raced off to the airport at Tampa and caught a place to Los Angeles. I arrived in Los Angeles at night. As I’m sure you all know, the Sea Org places a great significance on what they call security. There was to be one security-cleared person meeting me at the airport and nobody else was supposed to know he was coming to meet me. It was very confidential and I had to go with him. I was still quite mystified as to why I was being called to California. We took off down the highway and headed off toward Palm Springs. After we got started down the freeway he said, “Look, no offence or anything, but you have to wear these dark glasses.” I said, “Why? It’s night time.” He has a pair of sunglasses they’d sprayed aluminum paint on the inside of so that you couldn’t see through them and he wanted me to put these on so I wouldn’t see where we were going as it was so secret that even I shouldn’t know.

It was about one o’clock in the morning by this time and I’d been flying for many hours and could do with some sleep. I put the glasses on and dozed off. We eventually came to the exit we were going to take near Palm Springs and the driver almost overshot it. He hit the brakes suddenly and I was jostled and the glasses flew off just as the sign came up on the freeway that said “Indo Exit.” I picked up the glasses and put them back on. The guy who was driving said, “Oh God! I hope you didn’t see that sign.” I said, “Well you’d get into trouble if I did, wouldn’t you?”. “Yeah.” He said. I responded, “Then I didn’t see anything about Indio.” And he said, “Oh great.”

Finally we arrived at the headquarters of CMO Int, La Quinta at about four o’clock in the morning. I was taken into the house where LRH was living and was told that LRH had become quite ill and they were concerned about whether he was going to live or not and that was why I had been brought there. I had some of his folders given to me, I studied them and got ready to give him a session. It had been some time since I had seen LRH. When I went into his bedroom I must admit I got quite a shock, because the last time I’d seen him he’d been full of energy and active and it was a surprise to see him lying on his back in the bed and in the physical condition he was in.

I had some folders and the main thing that I could see from the folders was that he’d been having quite a lot of auditing on NED and that there were various strange indications. His TA had been getting higher and higher and the needle had been getting tighter. Various somatics had been turning on and the more somatics that turned on, the more they’d try and run these somatics out with NED and then the more somatics would turn on, and so on. He wasn’t able to speak. He was lying there almost in a coma although he had his eyes open. When I went into the room and said hello to him his eyes flickered and he gave a little smile. I put the cans in his

hands. From the folder I'd ascertained certain things that were probably the cause of the bypassed charge and I'd written up a little C/S. The first thing I did was ask these questions to locate the bypassed charge. His TA was up around five or five and a quarter and the needle was almost stuck. I had to have the sensitivity cranked up to get any reads and when I checked through my list of possible sources of bypassed charge and got something that read, I indicated it and the TA came down about a quarter of a division, and we got a very, very small F/N, at which point I ended the first assist. And then about an hour or two later I did another short assist session, and this time at the end of that session he was talking. Two hours later I did the third session. During that session he got up out of bed and sat in the chair and it lasted for about a quarter of an hour and we got normal F/N at the session end. He was starting to smile and even cracked a little joke. From then on in September '78 I audited him daily. Usually about two sessions a day, sometimes three sessions a day, for quite some time thereafter.

Because my post was Senior C/S Flag and I had been absent for some time from Flag, people were starting to ask questions as to where I was. The CMO decided to invent a 'shore story'. A 'shore story' is Sea Org slang for a story that is false. It's intended to give people something to think about so that they won't consider the real reason.

Anyway, it wasn't a very big secret for very long and at that point I still didn't know where I was located. They'd done all sorts of funny things there at CMO Int. They had taken all the local newspapers away and disconnected the TV in case I'd accidentally saw what channels were on. But they left all the telephone books beside the telephones. And then one day I said that a friend of mine's birthday was coming up and I wanted to be able to go to town and buy a birthday present and mail it off. So somebody said, "Oh sure." And I got in the car with them and we went into town and bought a birthday present and then at some time later it was decided that it would be okay for me to know where I was.

Regarding the auditing I was doing on LRH in September '78. It was out of that auditing that the whole subject of NOTs, or Ned for OTs, was developed. Within a month LRH had fully recovered his health and was active again. That was an extremely pleasing thing. And I felt it was a great honor at the time to have been his auditor and C/S throughout that period. I did the auditing and I also C/Sed the folder between sessions because there wasn't anybody else to do it. Most of the techniques I was using at the time, had to be developed between each session. Initially I set out to help him recover his health and that was accomplished. Then from that point on we started to discover that we were making some very astounding gains with this auditing. And then he asked me to make it possible for other people to get trained on these techniques so it could be released, and scientologists generally would be able to get this same rundown. So in late November and December of 1978 he asked me to write up all of the techniques and processes and all the technical data involved so it could be exported. Most of my days at that time were spent either auditing him or getting the next C/S ready for the next session, or typing up the materials that had been run thus far. Then I'd go into his office and we'd sit down and he would read over the write-ups, which later became HCOBs. He would read over them and we would discuss them and sometimes he would make additions to them or change the writing style so that it would more closely emulate his. By late December the majority of it was completed. We put a checksheet together and a mission was send off to Flag to train the first NOTs auditors at Flag. I was still auditing LRH at the time so other people were sent on that mission and then, toward the end of it, I flew out there and helped do the final training on them, and the training of the C/Ses who were going to C/S it.

That was the release of NED of OTs in the end of 1978 and early 1979. Flag, and later the AOs, got a tremendous boom throughout 1979 on NOTs. That went on for some years. After the release of NOTs at Flag

in early '79 I continued auditing LRH. There were further developments and refinements as we went along. There is a tremendous amount of the original research data and techniques that have actually never been released. Now and then we occasionally hear of a "new discovery" but from what I've heard of them I don't think they're that new.

I audited LRH up through June 1979, at which point he completed his audited NOTs and went on to what was later called Solo NOTs. One of the things that was necessary to develop in order for him to be able to do Solo was a meter that would pick up the very fine reads that one gets at that level on a pair of solo cans. You see, when I started auditing him on NOTs, there was no such thing as a Mark VI meter. There was only a Mark V. And that was adequate if a person was holding two cans, one in each hand. But when we attempted to see if he

could solo audit on a Mark V reads wouldn't show up and he would have to hold the cans in two hands and then you'd see a read. We often would test it and it seemed at the time that the whole of NOTs would have to be audited on somebody by an auditor. It seemed like it wouldn't be possible to solo audit it because of this inability of the Mark V meter to pick up reads with just a solo can. So he sent some instructions off and some people

at Pubs Org at Los Angeles started working on developing a more sensitive meter. Then it became possible for him to go on to Solo and he began what later became Solo Nots. I C/Sed his folder on Solo NOTs and occasionally when he ran into something I'd be called and would go in there and do a review session. Auditing LRH was quite an experience in itself. I don't know whether I could adequately describe it. It was extremely enlightening. I'm sure those of you who are auditors know how interesting it is to audit any pc on anything, and see the pc go along running something and suddenly have a cognition. With LRH it was a similar sort of thing only about a hundred times more so. And so each day I'd wonder what new cognition or discovery would unfold in the session.

I used to have a tremendous number of cognitions sitting there auditing LRH. He'd be running something and he'd say, "No, it's not really like that. It must be like this." And then he'd go. "Oh yes!" And then he'd run a time when something to do with that occurred. And then something else. And then he'd suddenly cognite and then I'd sit there listening to this, and I'd think, "Oh my God! Yeah, that's right." I think I got at least as many cognitions from auditing him as I did from sessions on myself.

I C/Sed him on his Solo NOTs and he eventually completed the level and later asked me to write up all the materials related to Solo NOTs and export it. I did this towards the end of 1980. Solo NOTs was then released to the world. I got an enormous amount of experience during that time, not just on the subject of NOTs and Solo NOTs, but also on how one goes about researching new technology and developing it.

After LRH completed Solo NOTs he continued on with solo auditing, researching the levels above that and eventually completed up through OT 11.

It should be mentioned, at this point, that LRH kept me informed regarding his research basically because he wanted me to be able to continue on with that technical hat and assume it fully when he left the body. I

received in April 1982 a very significant dispatch from LRH. It was approximately twenty pages long. In it, he described what he anticipated in the future and specifically over the next twenty to twenty five years. He stated that he wanted me to carry on and release the new OT levels at the appropriate time. He actually turned the hat over. He also told me at the time that he expected to live for a minimum of a few months, perhaps a couple of years at the most, and there were paragraphs in which he told me not to get upset about the idea of his dropping his body and pointed out (and I'm mentioning this because I think it's relevant and I think most people should know it) that it wasn't something to be sad about. He said that he'd accomplished what he'd set out to accomplish in this lifetime, which was basically to map out the bridge. He wanted to go on and be able to start a new game. And he also estimated that he would be gone for some time. He didn't say doing what. He asked me basically to look after three things concerning the tech. One was overseeing the quality of delivery of tech by other people and to ensure that high quality delivery continued. A second thing was that I was to look over the actual technical materials from time to time, because they would require updating as society changed. And thirdly, at suitable times in the future, I was requested to release the as-yet-unreleased OT levels. He made an important point. This was that by the time I and others had gotten up through these levels, we would find that it was possible to continue on with the research ourselves, and that he felt that the future was now secure. He didn't have to be around forever to continue on mapping the route out. He had done enough. And he therefore felt that he'd fulfilled his goals and what he referred to as his obligations to mankind, and could go and do something else. He did say that he would check back in twenty to twenty-five years to ensure it was all going well.

There is another aspect of that dispatch which I don't think has been mentioned before. Although it didn't see very significant at the time, a few months after that I got another dispatch from him. It was more of an administrative dispatch rather than technical. He asked me to start thinking about how I might best organize myself and my staff in order to be able to fulfill the duties he had stated in the earlier dispatch. He said I would have to reorganize things differently from the way they were. There was a little explanation to the effect that people who were involved in tech and people who were involved in administration often don't see things the same way and he pointed out that the technical people often are more concerned with the purity of the tech and its application, whereas some of the administrative people have their attention on stats more than the tech and this can cause a variance...

I believe it was quite understated. It said that it could cause a variance or a difference in viewpoints on how things should be done. And, as I say, some of the full significance of it didn't dawn on me at the time. But he said that in addition to thinking about how to organize my unit so as to be able to fulfill the purposes and duties that he'd laid out in the earlier dispatch. He said that I should also consider a possibly different corporate and organizational basis in which to operate. I won't go so far as to say that he predicted or necessarily suggested what was to occur later. But looking back on it now, it may well be that way, that he may have anticipated what was going to happen on the next few years and the rest of '82 and '83 up the present.....

“Resistance is Futile”

- The ‘Borg’ Star Trek

There is a basic principle which we are all acquainted with. “What you resist you become”. This principle can be clearly seen throughout history. The Romans resisting Christianity so much Rome becomes the seat of the Catholic Empire. The Americans wearing German Helmets just after the war. The US Government adopting the Communist Manifesto in principle if not in name. The Russias becoming more ‘capitalistic’ every day. And now the rife misuse and altering of tech, ethics and finance policies by the C of S. The C of S has resisted altered and out tech, out ethics and destructive finance policies so much they have now become the seat of it.

In a 1954 PDC Tape (Tape 20) Ron predicted that the technology of scientology would be used destructively against the scientology organisation and it’s basic goals and principles. 50 years later, we have lived to see this prophecy come true. The Church has resisted alteris-ed tech and misapplied ethics to the point where they now practice it themselves. Squirrel tech and haphazard Sec Checks have subsequently resulted in a bridge altered so many times and processes dropped and changed so much that no one quite knows, at first glance, what the truth is anymore within the church. Basic principles have been changed. Tapes and books altered and vital data missing. The blanket use of ethics to stop and used as a punishment rather than getting tech in. The finance polices perverted to price the services out of reach of all but the wealthy or those willing to violate the exchange principles and dive into debt in a desperate attempt to go free (an alter is and a contradiction in terms if ever there was one). So it seems the Church has resisted misuse of the technology to such a marked degree that they themselves have now ended up misusing the technology in precisely the same way they were resisting it in the first place.

Be aware however, this basic principle hold no allegiance and so could quite easily apply in the freezone just as much as it has done in the Church.

How do we ensure we do not ‘resist’ that, I hear you ask. How do we ensure we do NOT fall into the same trap. How do we ensure we handle effectively altered technology, ethics and policy without resisting it? The answer is very simple and is contained within the technology itself. Not only did Ron discuss the problem but he also gave us the answer as well. The Church would have been resoundingly successful if, instead of rejecting those it considered out-ethics, out-tech, off policy and issuing streams of SP orders to cut comm and absolve responsibility, it had actually instituted a project of handling the individual. Not with punishment and declaring anyone and everyone but using the basic technology such as study tech, auditing, correct ethics handlings with a view to getting the technology in where it was not. Also instituting a measure of self correction, particularly at the upper levels of Management. If they had admired the individuality of people and put that to good use rather than resist it with all their might. If they had, instead of lashing out with legal suits in all directions, instead communicated with those they disagreed with. They just might have salvaged the church.

As it stands, the Freezone is resisted to such a degree that church adherents are not allowed to look in the direction of the freezone. A sure guarantee of ‘you get what you resists’ as they have satisfactorily (to my mind) placed the Freezone out of their area of responsibility and therefore control.

Well....you might say. For the Church resist away! But how do **we** resist the urge to resist?

It is a matter of what one puts ones attention on.

One gets that which one places ones attention on. If one’s attention is placed on the negative aspects of the issue then of course that is what one is going to get. If the emphasis is placed more on the positive accent then that is what one will get. In practical terms this means promoting the Freezone as the answer to mans problems. As the route to freedom. Not on harping on the problems or the poor media or the legal issues the Church has. It means pouring the hot coals on the purpose of the Freezone. Getting more people in and moving up the bridge. Going Clear and OT. Doing that which has been successful Promoting the bridge Ron originally issued and getting people up it. We can take advantage of the resistance of the Church for this will give us more people. The more the Freezone is resisted the more it will encroach upon that which resists it. Not because we desire so but because it is one of the laws of this particular universe. In that sense we will win provided we get everything else right

What *IS* Standard Tech?

Chris (Class VIII C/S, OT VII)

I have seen much talk and posting/counter-posting on the subject of what “Standard Tech” is, including, mostly, posters’ views, ideas, and opinions on what it is. The Church certainly does not seem to understand what Standard Tech is when you consider the amount of alter is and change that has occurred in their brand of technology So I thought I would take a few quotes from a Class VIII lecture number 4 of the 27 September 1968 entitled “Standard Tech Defined”, These are fair use quotes in this discussion of what is Standard Tech really is as it is far better to have it from source! And to be honest, I his view of what Standard Tech is makes a whole helluva lot of sense.

So, here is Ron’s take on what Standard Tech is:

These are fair use quotes used to illustrate a point regarding Standard Tech.

“Now, let’s take it up from the beginning. What does the word *Scientology™* mean? If there seems to be a little bitterness in that.... Scio is the word fore ‘truth’. And *scio* turns into *scien* in that form, which means truth. And *ology* is ‘the study of’. Truth, study of.”

“Now, if you’re studying truth, how the hell can there be a variable? Truth, by definition, is what is. There is a direct relationship to the amount of variable in a person’s life – and complications, which are untruths – and his state of case.”

“So that an OT comes up the line toward truth. And the more truth there is in him the higher his case level - by direct proportion.”

“So anyway, Scientology is well named. It is the road to truth. It is a study of the truth. And total truth is total power. And when the guy hasn’t got any lies left in him, he’s OT. And all the mechanics of OT work out too. So the subject is *very, very* well named. And that’s what Scientology means. It’s the study of truth, to which could be added the technology of achieving truth.”

“A science is a body of truths. A technology is a body of truths. Now, somebody who can’t confront action, or something like that, thinks a truth would be a datum of some kind or another. Well, a truth can also be an action. And the road through all of the untruths of a person, from all the way south to all the way north, has been mapped. It exists. It has been on a chart for years. There have been bulletins which announced its processes. The doingness of those processes are exact, precise! There aren’t two ways to do them. There is only one way to do them.”

“This is *Webster’s Third International Dictionary*.... The word *standard*. It means ‘*a definite level or degree of quality that is proper and adequate for a specific purpose*’. And that one you can star-rate. Got it?”

“...*technology*: ...it’s ‘the science of the application of knowledge to a practical purpose; applied science’. Have you got it?”

“But Scientology has a very definite body of technical application, which is the *only* body of technical application in all of the data of Scientology. There are not two ways to do anything in Scientology.”

“Now, if Scientology’s definition is ‘the road to truth’, then what are the progressive Grade Processes? They are those barriers, in that order, which keep a person from going forward to an ultimate truth. So if you looked at a normal pc, you might see something on the order of – there he is parked in ‘Ditty-wah-ditty. You ever hear of ‘Ditty-wah-ditty’? That’s actually ten miles on the other side of hell. Now, that’s where the people in hell go on their night out.

“But anyway, he’s over here in ‘Ditty-wah-ditty’. Now, he’s going to walk all the way, the whole route, see? Now, these grades are the gates across the road. One, nobody knew the road; they didn’t know he was down there; they didn’t know any of the gates across the road. And standard tech simply takes this fellow and he walks him right straight up the line through these exact gates. And if you walk him through any other gates, you’re just detouring./ There aren’t any other barriers on the track. These are the shut gates on his road up the line. And they are the Grade Processes. And it isn’t just an illusion. It is the fact. And because it is a fact – if you know your job expertly – you simply go along and open each gate for him, shove him through, go to the next gate and open and shove him through, and open the next gate and shove him through.”

“Now, there’s 8,750 billion other things you could do with the case, none of which would put him any further along the road he’s supposed to travel. But boy, would they be interesting. And anytime else in man’s history, all they’ve done (if they did find out there was somebody in ‘Ditty-wah-ditty’) is they sent him a little closer to hell. They didn’t even have the dream that there might be a road out. So how far up the line do you have to come to grasp this thing called standard tech?”

“There is a guy; there’s a dream of a road out. There is a road. There’s a complete ocean of wrongnesses. But what has been isolated are the *exact* barriers to the *exact* road that takes him out.”

“And standard tech – when the guy has gone over into left field, right field, off the road, into the telegraph pole, something like that – also gives you the technology of taking him and putting him back on the road. And there aren’t eight ways to do it. And it doesn’t require any opinions.”

“So the thing that keeps standard tech standard is following standard tech – not anybody else’s advice. ...I’ll tell you something ghastly. In eighteen solid years of research I kept the door wide open to any research suggestion of any kind whatsoever. And from the moment I wrote the last sentence of Dianetics: *The Modern Science of Mental Health*, right on up the line, I would have been only too glad to have accepted a workable action. But every time I did, it got us in trouble. It might have stayed with it a short period of time. It might have appeared workable a short period of time. But in the final analysis, it got us in trouble.”

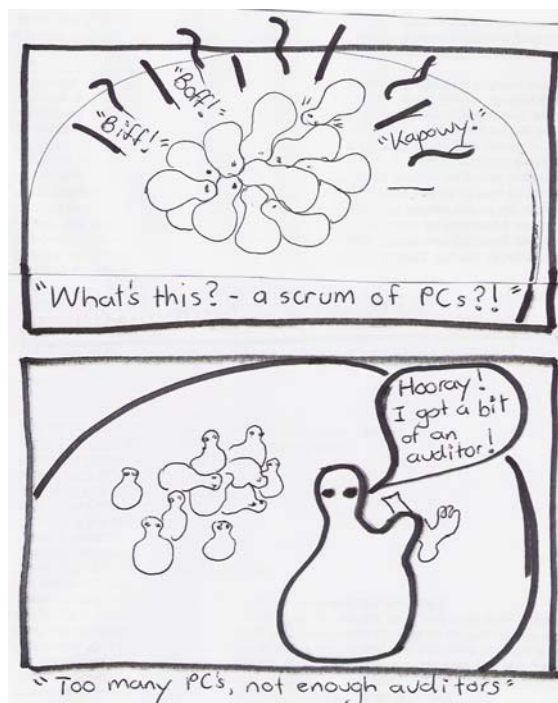

I just passed my ham exams -- all three including the one on Morse code and I want to share with you a big win I had with S-A lists during my ham cram.

As you probably guessed most of my life was on hold as I studied for my amateur radio license. Lots of new technical topics and that Morse code, such a tricky thing. We would love to crash for a well deserved rest, but this is the British Virgin Islands and they are strict about the newly arrived checking in with Customs pronto. So ... Launch the dinghy! I thought I would miss all but one or two letters. As it turned out I got everything except one or two letters. Wow!

A few of the Clearing Course lectures were recorded on records (vinyl records!). Anybody got a record player that plays 78's? That may have been an impulse to upgrade to a more popular medium at the time, but, it was premature in its debut before Hi Fi Stereo 33 1/3's and 45's and fraught with drawbacks. So thankfully we don't have to slap on a short stack of records to play a lecture.

The workhorse R2Rs (reel-to-reel) tapes carried the day thanks in part to being sustained by other than music industry users. But in the end they too are history.

C of S switched over to cassettes late in the game thankfully so after 8 track had come and gone. Recently I was in a Radio Shack store asking about buying a replacement cassette deck player and was told they no longer sell them. So if you have any old media such as cassettes or R2Rs laying around you will want to get them converted to mp3 and on to CDs at least. More on that in the next Journal issue.

Current data shows that CD life span guesstimates of 100 years for CD-R and 30 years for CD-RW are grossly overstated. Problems include variations in the film material and the thin label side corrosion from environmental factors and such things as the acid in ball-point pens. Already CDs (traditional? and mp3) are just about "old hat" as the media of choice today are music libraries stored on 20 and 40 gig iPods and the like directly from your hard drive downloads.

In the not too distant future what we have and what we know of Lafayette. Ron Hubbard will be what has been passed down from ourselves in a previous lifetime (this one). We do not want BOTWO (Based On The Works Of) versions and/or altered materials. Libraries regularly toss our books in the dumpster. Older versions of audio and books for the most part are out of print and circulate on eBay and 2nd bookstores but for how long? And what happens should the demand suddenly pick up?

And so we have the Tech Research and Preservation Project.

New Qual Service

Also, in keeping with KSW and the Qual functions of our Org Board I'd like to announce yet another new service for our IFA members. This will be a *Verification & Authentication* service. For written materials this will be in the form of an "Errata Page" (errata slip) for each printing edition of your books. This way you will have a corrections list of typos, dropped out text, altered text, added text etc. for which any older version of book or other material can be made complete and fully up to date.

Word and Concept Positioning

What does it mean for the Freezone?

Word and Concept Positioning is actually a marketing exercise in how you differentiate your product or service in the mind of your prospect. It also works in other fields such as propaganda where it may have originated.

This system is based on the concept that communication can only take place at the right time and under the right circumstances.

Positioning is what you do to the mind of the prospect - you look for the solution of your problem inside the prospect's mind. Anyone can use positioning strategy to get ahead in the game of life.”

I am not talking about new and invented words. I am talking about existing words that have been altered in meaning. This is never more demonstrated than in the deliberate changing of the word GAY from the original meaning of ‘happy and carefree’ to the new definition: ‘homosexual’. This was a very successful attempt to justify the homosexual position in society and portray homosexual people as happy and carefree. This is not a discussion on homosexuality and this is simply used as a very clear example of how effective word positioning can be. If one suddenly comes out and says how gay one is feeling the impression people will get now is vastly different to the impression they would have had just 20 years ago. It is unlikely, in fact, that anyone younger than 20 will know the original meaning of the word. That meaning is now lost. An alteration has taken place. Many words have undergone a change in meaning either deliberate or unintentional through word and concept positioning. It is a marketing tool and even, to some degree a political tool.

As an example, in our arena the definition of the word. ‘Squirrel’ has been repositioned by the Cof\$ from its original meaning: ‘going off into weird practices or altering Scientology’ –(ref: KSW), to mean: ‘anyone using Scientology without the authority of the Cof\$’. This is a deliberate attempt to change the definition for political reasons.
